Testing your blood glucose

Accu-Chek Compact Plus comes with batteries pre-installed, and the date and time pre-set. Accu-Chek Compact Plus will automatically code on insertion of the test strip drum.

Inserting or replacing a test strip drum

Testing blood glucose



Open drum compartment cover.



Pull down the test button to advance a test strip.



Press the red drum release button.



Hold the meter so the test strip is pointing downwards. Touch the drop of blood against the front edge of the test strip where the black notch is located. The test strip draws up blood.



Tip the meter forwards, the test strip drum drops out.



See display for meter reading.



Insert new test strip drum.



Pull down the test button to eject the used test strip.



ACCU-CHEK Softclix Plus

The Accu-Chek Softclix Plus lancing device can be detached from the Accu-Chek Compact Plus meter using the slide button on the back of the meter, or used whilst still attached.





Remove the cap from the lancing device.



Press the cap back on to the lancing device. The cap snaps in to place with a click.



Press the plunger at the top of the lancing device to eject the used lancet.



Twist the cap to the desired depth setting (11 settings in total).



Slide a new lancet in to the lancet holder and push it in until it clicks in to place.



Press the plunger all the way down. The plunger returns about a third of the way. The lancing device is now primed.



Remove the protective cap from the lancet with a twisting motion.



Place the lancing device against the chosen test site, press the plunger at the top of the lancing device down again until it clicks to obtain a sample.

The Accu-Chek Softclix Plus lancing device is intended for patient self-monitoring by a single person. It must not be used to collect blood in a multi-patient setting as it does not incorporate any features to guard against cross-infection.
